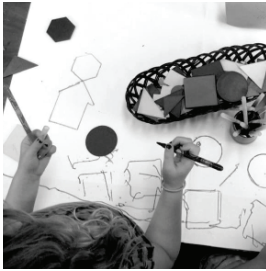

NURTURING EARLY YEARS WITH DROP-OFF MORNING & AFTERNOON CLASSES



ART+ Program - Ages 3-5 Years Old

Children come selected days and have options of staying the afternoon.

Kaleidoscope has morning drop-off classes which extends to afternoons- sign up for a minimum of 3 days to a whole week. Based on holistic theories of learning (such as Montessori, Waldorf and Reggio Emilio) these classes follow the Kaleidoscope philosophy that children should learn through art, exploration and play. Each day has a learning theme and every day incorporates loose parts, messy play, outdoor activities and a whole lot of child-focused learning! Art+ classes are led by teacher Kelly Smith who has over a decade of experience in early childhood education and is passionate about nurturing each child's unique potential.

Sign up is by term but days can be selected as follows:

Mondays - Art+ Math,
Tuesdays - Art+ Garden & Science,
Wednesdays - Art+ Movement & Rythm,
Thursdays - Art+ Literacy,
Fridays - Art+ more Art!

Morning Details

The morning program runs from 8:30am-12:30pm each day. Sign up is for the term & children must be toilet independent.

Children can stay for extended day until 3pm. Sign up for as many days per week as you like, but sign up is for the term.
